JOB CAMP VCAL 90 meets the VCAL Industry Specific Skills Strand requirement to complete accredited units of competence that total a minimum of 90 nominal hours and equal **One Credit**.

JOB CAMP VCAL 90 comprise essential Skill Sets necessary for entry level sector employment.



JOB CAMP VCAL 90 – Hospitality requires a minimum of **Six** dedicated training days.

Day **One**, **Two**, **Three** and **Four** are allocated to training and formulative assessment across food safety, coffee and non-alcoholic beverages, whereby students transition across a **Six Station Rotation** within a high energy simulated workplace environment. Day **Five** is dedicated to first aid practical training and Day **Six** RSA (face to face or virtual).

Students must complete additional **theory based learning** to support underpinning knowledge of each unit of competence.

*Units of competence delivered and assessed as a cluster whereby students work with a buddy, in a group of four, rotating across six practical training stations, under the guidance of **two industry trainers**.
